



KAHPA Healthcare Career Scholarship 2010 High School Student Application

Introduction:

Korean American Health Professional Association (KAHPA) is a non-profit organization of healthcare professionals including physicians, nurses, pharmacists, and others in the healthcare industry. KAHPA's mission is manifold- to provide Korean-American health professionals with a forum for networking, to offer mentorship to Korean-American students interested in healthcare careers, and to educate Korean-Americans about health-related topics through community service programs in the greater Seattle area.

Scholarship:

A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior of Korean descent from the greater Seattle area who demonstrates the most outstanding potential to pursue a career in healthcare.

Requirements:

- At least part-Korean or Korean-American descent
- Graduating senior from a greater Seattle-area high school
- Plan to pursue a degree in a 2- or 4-year college program
- Completed application
- Official high school transcript
- Reference letter (1) from a high school advisor or teacher

Timeline:

The application, including all supplemental materials, must be completed by May 8, 2010. A panel of healthcare professionals from KAHPA will review completed applications and a winner and 1st runner-up will be notified on June 15, 2010. In the event that the winner does not fulfill the requirements as above, the scholarship will be awarded to the 1st runner-up.
